Dr. Jackson presented an update to the Five-Year Financial Forecast. Due to SEA 1 and HEA 1001, the school corporation is expecting a reduction in revenue of \$3.1M in the next two years compared to the forecast presented in January. The updated forecast includes a reduction of five (5) teaching positions, and a reduction of \$100,000 in software and \$100,000 in supplies for a total savings of around \$700,000. The teaching positions would be eliminated through attrition.

Dr. Jackson recommended approval of the 2025-26 TigerTown Parent/Student Handbook and Latchkey Handbook. Mr. Gellert made a motion, seconded by Mr. Scholl, to approve the Handbooks. The motion carried by voice vote.
