HOMELESS STUDENTS ARE THOSE WHO LACK FIXED, REGULAR, AND ADEQUATE NIGHTTIME RESIDENCE. THIS INCLUDES STUDENTS WHO $\Delta \text{PF}^{\text{-}}$

- SHARING THE HOUSING OF ANOTHER PERSON DUE TO LOSS OF HOUSING, ECONOMIC HARDSHIP, OR SIMILAR REASON
- LIVING IN MOTELS, HOTELS, TRAILER PARKS, OR CAMPGROUNDS DUE TO LACK OF ALTERNATIVE ADEQUATE ACCOMMODATIONS
- LIVING IN EMERGENCY OR TRANSITIONAL SHELTERS
